Putting clinical trial diversity front and center in our development programs by incorporating details, considerations and context around diversity in our clinical trial design; building strategies for engaging a diverse and representative patient sample across the entire development program; and constructively working with patient and community stakeholders to increase trial diversity.



Better understanding the patient journey differences experienced by diverse populations to inform our development programs.



Educating and discussing the importance of representation with physicians and others involved in our clinical trials.



Addressing how we communicate and disseminate health information to patients, e.g., exploring approaches to build digital strategies and develop content for certain disease states to reach patient populations we haven't previously engaged.
